Lake Winnebago has 12 miles of state, county and city parks, 100 Cliff State Park is the only state park on Lake Winnebago. The lake is north of the city. The lake has camping, boating, beautiful views of the lake, a marina, water conservation, and picnicking.

Lake Winnebago is one of the more heavily fished lakes in the state. Many fishermen consider it one of the nation's top walleye fisheries. Other species present include bluegill, largemouth bass, muskellunge, northern pike, perch, burbot, white bass, Crappie, freshwater drum, channel catfish, flathead catfish, and smallmouth bass.

The fishing is popular on Lake Winnebago. It is not uncommon for 10,000 cars to park on Lake
