Improvements on the property include a Japanese style bath house, a shed/ bunkhouse, 2 storage sheds for water tanks, an outhouse and a large shell enclosing a 28' Skyline Nomad 5th wheel that is included in the sale. Potable water is provided by a developed spring that has a 132 gallon collection tank. From the collection tank, a solar pump pumps water uphill into a 265 gallon holding tank at the top of the property. From there it is gravity fed to the camper. With the camper already in place this property can be enjoyed as a weekend getaway or as living quarters while you build a cabin.

If you enjoy hunting, hiking, ATVing or snowmobiling, this mountain property provides a unique ownership opportunity. With the Encampment River, North Platte River and Hog Park Reservoir just a short drive from the property, even the avid angler will appreciate this property's location.
