

- \$3,500 (est.) in labor to remove all "popcorn" ceilings except in closets and remove old cabinetry and appliances from kitchen
- \$4,500 for new Trane AC unit with 10 year transferable warranty
- \$7,000 in new windows throughout
- \$10,000 in new hardwood flooring in the rest of the unit
- \$9,500 in new kitchen appliances
- \$2,500 in new kitchen counter tops
- \$20,000 in new kitchen cabinets

\$1,500 in electrical work to install dimmers, great room ceiling lights, in-cabinet and under-cabinet

lighting and the...
 \$500 to remove ceiling...
 \$300 for new fire... (material... for cost...
 \$400 for new fire... and install... propane...
 All door hardware throughout was replaced, as well as cabinet pulls in the bathrooms.

\$800 -- both bathroom and both bedroom doors are new... they were rather expensive, but more sound proof than the previous ones - they were about \$75 per door plus labor for mortising and installation
 \$1,200 for time and materials for installing upgraded soundproofing under the wood flooring
